2022 Senior Living Congressional Hero Award Recipient: Senator Susan Collins (R-ME)

The 2022 ASHA Congressional Hero Award was presented to Senator Susan Collins (R-ME) at ASHA's Executive Board Meeting on September 13th in Washington, DC. Senator Collins has been a champion for older Americans and the senior living industry throughout her 25-years of service in the U.S. Senate.

At the beginning of the COVID-19 pandemic, Senator Collins was instrumental in supporting the creation of the Provider Relief Fund (PRF) and securing relief for senior living providers. When remaining dollars were at risk of being repurposed, Senator Collins stood strong in opposition to ensure these funds were not diverted and remained in the PRF, available to assist health care providers recovering from the pandemic.

In Senator Collins' role as a senior member on the Senate Appropriations Committee, she has helped to secure billions of dollars in funding to advance research to find a cure for Alzheimer's disease.

Senator Collins served as Chair of the Senate Aging Committee from 2015 - 2021 and has a reputation for finding solutions to serious issues of the day and working across the aisle to get legislation passed and signed in to law.

Congressional Recess is the best time to invite your Member of Congress to your communities to show off the innovative programs you offer your residents and the value you bring to seniors and your staff. The U.S. House of Representatives will be available in their state/ district the month of October for a Congressional Recess leading up to the November mid-term elections.

As ASHA advocates for immigration reform to help with the senior living workforce, this is a perfect opportunity for you to discuss the need for such action by Congress and to stress that this is an issue they need to work on now. SH PAC Disbursements 2021-2022*

The Seniors Housing PAC has disbursed \$845,000 so far for the 2021-2022 election cycle, supporting 55 U.S. Senators and 114 Members of the U.S. House of Representatives. ASHA's Public Policy Committee serves as the steering committee for the Seniors Housing Political Action Committee. Disbursements to the campaigns of Federal candidates are made according to a broad strategy that includes supporting those who are knowledgeable, supportive, and key to the advancement of public policy that impacts the seniors housing industry.

Legislative Spotlight:

"Expanding Veterans' Options for Long Term Care Act" Gains Co-Sponsors in the Senate and Companion Bill Introduced in House

Originally introduced in the Senate on May 10th, the Expanding Veterans' Options for Long Term Care Act (S. 4169) would create a three-year pilot program to give veterans who are currently residing in nursing homes and other eligible veterans, the option to transfer into a Medicaid certified assisted living community.

ASHA has been working to advance this important bipartisan legislation introduced by Senator Jon Tester (D-MT) that now has four co-sponsors in the Senate: Senator Jerry Moran (R-KS), Senator Patty Murray (D-WA), Senator Richard Blumenthal (D-CT), and Senator Angus King (I-ME) and interest is growing steadily.

Representative Elissa Slotkin (D-MI-08) introduced the House version of the bill (H.R. 8750) on August 26th with the support of Representative Stephanie Bice (R-OK-05), Representative Bryan Steil (R-WI-01), and Representative David Trone (D-MD-06).

ASHA has implemented grassroots efforts to generate letters of support from ASHA members to Congressional offices. ASHA will continue to work to secure co-sponsors in the House and Senate to advance this important legislation that would expand veterans' access to assisted living services.
