## ASHA Presents Senator Susan Collins with Senior Living Congressional Hero Award

Maine Senator Susan Collins received ASHA's 2022 Senior Living Congressional Hero Award during the ASHA Fall Executive Board meeting in Washington, DC. As the former Chair of the Senate Aging Committee and a leader on the powerful Appropriations Committee, Senator Collins was instrumental in the industry's efforts to secure Provider Relief Funds to help with the financial distress associated with the pandemic. She also played a crucial role in ensuring that unspent PRF funds were not diverted to pay for the bi-partisan Infrastructure Act. She is spearheading an effort with Senator Kyrsten Sinema (D-AZ) to streamline the process to grant migrants work authorization which could add workers to industries facing labor shortages including senior living. ASHA Executive Board members Bob Thomas of Senior Star and Richard Hutchinson of Discovery Senior Living presented the Senator with the award.

Let me truly start by commending all of the senior living professionals in the room and back in your businesses, for all the work that you do to help meet the needs of our nation's seniors. It is so important. As a senior representing the state with the highest median age, the oldest population — you all thought it was Florida? It's actually Maine. #### SH PAC Disbursements 2021 – 2022\*


For the two-year 2021-2022 election cycle, the Seniors Housing PAC has disbursed \$1,046,500 to 57 U.S. Senators and 130 Members of the U.S. House of Representatives.

The SH PAC strives to support candidates based on the composition of the House and Senate. SH PAC giving reflects the ratios of the majority/minority parties in Congress. With the majority party having control over what legislation is brought to the House and Senate floor, it is important to support the party in control. We recognize that bipartisan support is still needed for much legislation to pass, especially in the Senate, and taking this into account SH PAC supports Members on both sides of aisle.


## 2022 SH PAC Campaign Update


